### **Aims (as a working group)**

To upgrade and modernise the existing Play Spaces in Brixton Village at rear of Steer Point Road (owned by South Hams District Council), Yarda Walk and Kitley View (owned by Tor Homes)

To explore the possibility of these play spaces being part of an overall project to create a Play Trail in and around Brixton Village by using other public open spaces for children and young people in the community.

### **Tasks**

- To produce a design brief in consultation with children and young people on their preference for play equipment and play opportunities in and around the village.
- To identify a possible Play Trail in the village linking the current play spaces and other open spaces.
- To work in collaboration with landowners, the School, other local agencies and organisations to deliver the Play Trail and to contribute to the overall Scheme.
- To engage a Landscape Architect/Play Space Designer to draw up and cost plans to improve and upgrade the existing sites and make proposals for other opportunities in the village.
- To develop a project plan with milestones and timescales and to maximise current funding allocation of £10,000 from South Hams District Council by applying extensively for funding for the Play Trail.
- To enter into formal agreements with landowners of play trail sites.
- To plan long term for the maintenance, insurance and inspection.

### **Meetings**

Friends of Brixton Play Spaces will meet as necessary and as determined by the progress of the project. Other interested people from the community may join the group throughout the life of the project.

### **Reporting**

- The Friends of Brixton Play Spaces will report quarterly to Brixton Community Association General Committee meetings and to the Parish Council.
